



**Procurement of Supply, Implementation, and Operation of a Security Features and Security Features Management System (SFSFMS) for Liquor-Based Products for Excise Department of Sri Lanka**

1. The Chairman, High Level Procurement Committee (HLPC) on behalf of the **Excise Department of Sri Lanka** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Procurement of Supply, Implementation, and Operation of a Security Features and Security Features Management System (SFSFMS) for Liquor-Based Products for Excise Department of Sri Lanka.**

- To be eligible for contract award, the successful bidder shall not have been blacklisted. The qualification criteria for the eligible bidders shall include the following. (Detailed qualification requirements are given in the Procurement Documents):

i. The Bidder should have at least Five (5) years of business experience and be operational prior to the Bid Submission Deadline.

- (ii) The Bidder shall **have completed or have remained operational at least one project** involving a **Security Features Management System** for liquor-based products, which included the issuance of a minimum of **Six Hundred (600) Million foolproof stickers for Liquor-Based Products within two years** using the system in the capacity of a contractor. Such project must have been successfully completed within ten (10) Years prior to the Bid Submission Deadline or remained operational.

- system for liquor-based products. The referenced system must have a proven operational throughput capacity of a minimum of 45,000 bottles or cans per hour, in the capacity of a contractor. The reference project must have been successfully completed within the ten (10) years prior to the Bid Submission Deadline, or must currently remain fully operational.

Bidder shall be certified with ISO 9001, ISO 14298 or HSSMS, ISO 27001, ISO 37001 for Anti-Bribery Management Systems, the International Optical Technologies Association (IOTA) - formerly known as International Hologram Manufacturers Association (IHMA) and the International Tax Stamp Association (ITSA)

The bidder should have a minimum average annual turnover of **USD 5.0 million** as evidenced by audited financial reports, within the last three (3) years.

The Bidder must demonstrate access to or availability of financial resources, such as liquid assets, lines of credit, or other financial means, to meet the cash flow requirement of not less than USD 1.0 million, net of the Bidder's other commitments for this project.

4. A complete set of Procurement Documents in English may be purchased from Excise Department of Sri Lanka office (address above para 3) by interested bidders on the submission of a written request on a business letterhead, and upon payment of a **non-refundable fee of LKR 200,000.00 or the equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency in Sri Lanka**. The method of payment will be by cash.

5. Bids must be delivered to the address (above para 3) at **or before 3.00 p.m. on September 01, 2026**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after the bid closing in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend at **3.00 p.m. on September 01, 2026**. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the form of bank guarantee of not less than Sri Lankan Rupees Sixty million (LKR 60 million) or the equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency in Sri Lanka.

6. **A Pre- Bid Meeting** will be held at **10.30 am on August 04 2026**, at **Excise Department, Sixth Floor Auditorium, No. 353, Kotte Road, Rajagiriya**. All interested Bidders may participate to the Pre-Bid meeting. A site visits will be organized by the Employer on **August 05, 2026**.

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
